## The record of hearings

On 1<sup>st</sup> of September 1941 A. Kaiw, the officer of the 4<sup>th</sup> police ward of the Tallinn-Harju prefecture, interrogated in the rooms of the police ward

Movsha, son of Joseph, Rybak, born 9.6.1883, resident of Tallinn, Luha str. 40-1a, married, unpunished, who explained:

I am a Jew. I was working as a responsible manager of the sewing department at the knitting factory "Marat". I was not a member of the Communist party and did not participate in any communist activities. I did not like a communist rule, as at the time of estonian independence I owned a store and was a partner in the factory, thus a wealthy person. I did nothing to harm estonian people. I do not have anything else to add.
